**Discontinuance of Proceeding**

## **Facts**

The Appellant, Jason Schrage, agent for the Lethbridge Motorcycle Club, applied to Alberta Environment and Parks (“the Director”) for a Temporary Field Authorization (TFA) to host an off-road motorcycle race in the Crowsnest Pass Area on September 5 and 6, 2015. The Director refused the application due to concerns that portions of the event would take place within the proposed High Rock Wildland Provincial Park and that the event would take place within mountain goat and Bighorn sheep ranges during a time when no industrial activity is permitted.

A Notice of Appeal was filed by the Appellant with the Public Lands Appeal Board (“Board”) on July 30, 2015. The Appellant alleged that the Director did not comply with a regional plan approved under the *Alberta Land Stewardship Act*. The appeal was assigned the file number PLAB 15-0021.

In consultation with the parties, a mediation was scheduled for December 1, 2015. The parties met and discussed the appeal. An agreement was reached between the Appellant and the Director and the Appellant withdrew the appeal.

As the Appellant has withdrawn the appeal, the Board discontinues its proceedings and closes its file in the matter.

## **Rationale for Discontinuance**

As the Appellant has withdrawn their notice of appeal, and the Board is satisfied that all issues relating to the appeals have been resolved in accordance with section 123(8) of the *Public Lands Act*, the Board discontinues its proceedings and closes its file in this matter.
